- ii) Second session- Chief Guest lecture and Prize distribution ceremony (3 pm to 5.30 pm)


First Session - Various Competition

On this occasion we have organized various competitions for ladies staff such as Elocution competition, Singing competition, Poetry competition and Rangoli competition. For girls essay competition and elocution competition is organized. To enhance the presentation skill and performing skill of all the ladies is the main purpose behind organizing this competition. More than 50 participants from a ladies staff and more than 60 participants from a girls students participated in this event. For each event we have invited examiner. Dr. Vidyulatta Pandhare Madam, Principal of Uma Education College, Dr.Nagin Sarvgod Madam from Uma College, Sau. Aruna Haridas, Mr.Sitaram Sawant Sir worked as a examiner for the various competitions organized for ladies staff. Further a separate panel of examiners is also established for the evaluation of essay and elocution competitions for the girls students. The evaluation sheet and score cards are provided to all the examiners.

The rubrics for evaluation sheet are as follows i) Presentation skills ii) Time length iii) Communication skills iv) As per theme v) Overall impact. For all the winners cash prize, certificates and trophy is given. 
