Academic council exercising its powers approved the new syllabus and curriculum for all UG and PG courses suggested by respective Boards of Studies ,to be implemented from the academic year 2019-2020.

It was resolved that the recommendations made by Board of Studies for B.A.-I, B.Com.-I and B.Sc.-I, M.A.-I, M.Com-I and M.Sc.-I at its meeting held be accepted and that in accordance therewith, the syllabus for F.Y. B.A. F.Y.B.Com.and F.Y. B.Sc., M.A.-I, M.Com-I, M.Sc.-I be revised as suggested by BOS and the same be implemented from the academic year 2019-2020 by the following suggestions —

Prin. Dr, Mahendra Kadam suggested to reform in the evaluation pattern for the syllabus to be implemented from 2019-2020. The 60-40 pattern be accepted especially as there is lot scope for exposure of students in internal evaluation system..

When the president announced that K.B.P. Mahavidyalaya is going to implement the syllabus prepared by the autonomous colleges of Rayat Shikshan Sanstha - D.G. College, Satara, Shivaji College ,Satara and Y.C. Institute of Science, Satara, Prin. Dr. B.P. Ronge insisted that Autonomy gets disturbed due to following syllabus from other autonomous colleges of Sanstha. The right of Academic council gets limited due to such implementation of syllabus Prin. Dr. Mahendra Kadam - While accepting the syllabus credits allotted for the syllabus must be taken into consideration so the students will get proper justification. For this If the college is going to Confer on B.A. Hon. Degree to the students, the credits should be -6 and due to the 6 credits workload of the teachers will be increased. So the credit system should be accepted by

reshuffling it. There should be 148 periods for 6 credits.

After scrutinizing the Chemistry syllabus Dr. Mahendra Kadam Concluded that Credit list of Chemistry doesnot match.

So Credit should be as per the University Norms.
