A detailed discussion about the conducting online exam was held by members in Board of Examination and Evaluation . It was suggested by few faculty members that End Semester examination of this session can be conducted by developing the question papers in two parts i.e. one containing few Multiple-Choice Questions as part of End Semester Exams and another part containing some questions as part of Internal assessment as it may not be possible to conduct online internal assessment test/exams for all students TESTMOZ should be used for conducting the examinations. It was also suggested that question bank containing of hundreds of questions can be developed by faculty members and uploaded on college website to facilitate students to prepare for their exams.
